### Training and experience

Responsibilities of Full-time Instructors include:

- Instructing our on-site activities: High Ropes Course, Low Ropes Course, Team Building/Problem-Solving Activities, Environmental Studies, Orienteering, Aerial Runway, Crate-Stack Building, Team/wide games, Bushcraft, Canoeing, Kayaking, Raft Building
- You would be encouraged to gain any of the following qualifications that you do not already hold: First Aid, L2 Kayak and Canoe, Single Pitch Award, Walking Group Leader or ML Summer, Archery Leader, Trail Cycle Leader, Bushcraft Professional Development Course
- Assisting Senior Staff in the training of Summer Team, Gap-Year and Trainee Instructors
- Contributing to church youth work or music
- Preparing and delivering the Christian message in epilogues, morning thoughts and school assemblies
- General day to day domestic work, including serving at mealtimes, Centre cleaning and maintenance.



### Practical Details

Salary negotiable at interview, dependent on prior posts or qualifications held, and whether you would seek to live on, or off-site.

#### Costs for external courses

We do charge for sending you off-site to training and assessment courses run at other Centres. The way that we make this more manageable is to ask you to pay a contribution of £50/month into a personal training fund. This means that when a course comes up, then you are likely to have most of the funds already set aside, rather than having to pay a large sum straight out of your wages.

You will also have holiday entitlement that will be arranged with the Centre.
