

Assistant Team Leader

Pathway is looking to recruit a new team member to support the Team Leader. One specific focus will be on maintaining and strengthening the schools-based clubs, but he or she will also be involved in developing the wider ministry of Pathway.

About Pathway

Pathway is a charity that seeks to support local Churches in their outreach to children of primary school age. We work with local churches in taking Christian assemblies in primary schools and in running school-based Christian clubs. We also offer and deliver a range of RE lessons and workshops to primary schools.

We visit between 50 and 60 schools each half term and have contact with over 15,000 children regularly. We currently run 7 school-based Christian clubs.

Priorities for the role will be:

- **The ability to deliver school assemblies and lessons.**
- **The ability to teach the Bible to children and a commitment to the importance of doing so.**
- **The ability to source or plan a Bible-based club's curriculum and to train/oversee volunteers in Bible teaching.**

To fulfil the primary roles needed, **the candidate will need the following skills and aptitudes:**

- a mature Christian faith and to be of good standing in his or her church
- a passion and a heart for unchurched children and a desire to share Jesus with them
- creativity and experience in communicating with children and adults
- strong skills in relational communication, both in person and in writing
- capacity for self-management, initiative and good organisation skills, including working to deadlines
- ability and willingness to work as part of a team, including managing staff and volunteers of all ages

The role is full time during term times (39 weeks approx. per year) and part time (half time) during school holidays (approx. 13 weeks per year)*

Salary: £16,000 - £19,000 depending on experience

****Please note the salary reflects the fact that the role is not full time all year and includes 4 weeks annual paid leave as well as the half time hours in school holidays.***
