School of Spirit Life Ministry Internship

Do you want to be part of a Spirit-filled and led community, with time to focus on solidifying your identity as a child of God, while also developing skills in a specialist area of ministry?

Lighthouse London is a growing church with a big Spirit-filled vision; to be a light to the city and the nations. It was planted in 2006 from Holy Trinity Brompton and is an active part of the HTB Network. The last 2 years we have been pioneering a new course to equip people to live from their true spiritual identity. We recognise this is a need across the body of Christ and so the School of Spirit Life has been open to people from all churches. As an Intern you would take part in this programme with additional input from course leaders who would supervise your journey throughout your placement at Lighthouse church.

Lighthouse London believe part of our remit is to raise up Kingdom influencers, we want to pour into emerging leaders and provide them with practical learning opportunities. The Ministry Internship is a way to compliment your learning in the School with on the ground experience and opportunities for growth amidst an experienced team who are passionate about their ministries.

Interns would be able to specialise in one of the following: Children's Ministry Youth Ministry Worship Ministry

Structure:

The commitment is a 30 hours per week comprised of the following:

- 6 hours training
- 20 hours paid placement in your ministry at the London Living Wage (equivalent to £9,460 over the 10 month placement)
- 4 hours volunteering

Sunday would be regarded as one of your working days, and within your timetable space would be given for personal spiritual development and reflection; for example completing your Spirit-life Foundation assignments and activations.

You would be a student in the School of Spirit-Life Foundations.

You would be part of Lighthouse team for the duration of your Internship and so involved in all core activities; Sunday services, staff meetings, church community times away such as Focus or conferences.

There would be the potential to learn from and experience other Lighthouse ministries as your interests/gifting and opportunities allow; for example you might apply as Youth Ministry Intern because you have a particular passion for working with young people, but if you also had an interest in worship or inner healing we would look for you to be able to have time learning from those teams.

You would have regular supervision for personal reflection/coaching with both a School of Spirit Life tutor and your Ministry area Line-Manger.

This Internship is for 10 months with the possibility of a second year.

There would be a 6 week and 3 month mutual review to complete the probation period.

You would be entitled to 4 weeks holiday per year and all usual UK Bank Holidays.

There is the possibility of accommodation.

To be accepted for this Internship you would need to complete a DBS.

A willingness to participate in activities online is required - for example meetings over Zoom.

There is a degree of flexibility around start and end dates - to be agreed prior to commencement.

This could be a great opportunity for those exploring God's calling, including ordination in Church of England, and we actively encourage applications from people of ethnic minorities.
