

## **Job Description: Worship Pastor**

Contract; Full time 40 hours per week/ Part time 3 days a week  
Salary Band; £28,000 - £32,000

You will be a member of the pastoral staff team, responsible to the Parochial Church Council to deliver relevant worship at Sunday services and other church events and grow the culture of worship at ChristChurch. You will be expected to consider ChristChurch as your home church, and to fully accept the values and vision of the church.

It is a requirement to be a Christian and you will be required to work on Sundays and on other key religious celebrations, such as Christmas and Easter, unless otherwise agreed with your line manager.

### **Key Responsibilities**

#### **Worship Pastor**

- Develop and deliver a creative and adventurous vision for worship at ChristChurch.
- Lead, recruit, and train the worship team, including the Sound and AV team.
- Responsible for the worship equipment, instruments and sound desk.
- Encourage and promote worship within Christchurch.
- Worship Administration to include;
  - Maintain, process and implement necessary licences and copyrights
  - Introduce and write new songs
  - Maintaining the worship song files and sound desk facilities
  - Worship Rota and contact details
  - Ensure correct music licences and associated records are kept

#### **General**

- Develop a foundation of prayer for this area of ministry.
- Oversee the effective administration of both ministries which will include;
  - Responsible for drafting and managing the annual budgets
  - Plan and co-ordinate the programme of events for this ministry and contribute to the whole church planning process
- Contribute fully to the broader mission of ChristChurch.
- Learn, understand and apply the Jesus Ministry truths.
- To attend midweek staff meetings and attend Sunday services.
- To carry out any reasonable task as required by your line manager in support of the ministry work of ChristChurch.
