Working Hours:

The expectation will be to work 40 hours per week. The role calls for frequent travel throughout the year and some evening and weekend for speaking and networking engagements.

Authority:

The Director of Mobilising Director operates with delegated authority given by the CEO. This authority allows them to take such steps as they consider recruiting new workers to achieve agreed upon objectives in line with its strategy. This should be done in accordance with the GEM UK policies, and in adherence to the unique requirements of UK law, and in collaboration with the various external GEM stakeholders.

Key Responsibilities:

- Develop and implement a comprehensive strategy for mobilisation and partnership development to support the agency's mission and strategic objectives.
- Identify, cultivate, and manage relationships with key partners, including churches, organisations, and individual supporters, to enhance engagement and support.
- Lead the team responsible for mobilisation and partnership activities, providing direction, support, and development opportunities.
- Work closely with the communications team to develop effective messaging and materials that support mobilisation and partnership development efforts.
- Coordinate with the fundraising team to align partnership activities with fundraising strategies and goals.
- Represent the agency at events, conferences, and meetings, effectively communicating our mission and partnership opportunities.
- Monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of mobilisation and partnership initiatives, adjusting strategies as necessary to achieve goals.
- Stay informed of trends and developments in mission work, partnership development, and resource mobilisation to inform strategic planning.

Qualifications:

- Proven experience in a senior leadership role focused on partnership development, resource mobilisation, or a related field.
- Strong understanding of the UK church landscape and experience working with religious organisations and communities.
- Excellent relationship-building skills, with a track record of developing and maintaining strategic partnerships.
